

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act) **TWO SHEDS LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol from the premises situated at 3 Cooper Street, Masterton, and known as "Home Fields Wine", to any person for consumption off the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

ENDORSEMENT (Remote Sellers of Alcohol)

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) alcohol may be sold at any time on any day
- b) no alcohol is to be delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day
- c) alcohol may be delivered only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 6.00am to 11.00pm
- d) in the case of an order made using an internet site, the licensee must:
 - i. ask the prospective buyer to declare, by ticking an on-screen box, that he or she is 18 years of age or over (and, when a prospective receiver is involved, that the prospective receiver is also 18 years of age or over)
 - once when the prospective buyer first enters the internet site; and
 - again, immediately before the sale of any alcohol is completed
 - ii. refuse to sell alcohol to the prospective buyer unless, on both occasions, he or she declares that he or she is 18 years of age or over (and, where a prospective receiver is involved, also declares that the prospective receiver is 18 years of age or over)
- e) the licensee must ensure that there is printed on every receipt issued for alcohol sold remotely, the holders name and licence number, and the date on which the licence expires
- f) no direct sales to customers, or collecting of alcohol can be made from 3 Cooper Street, Masterton

Display of Licence

The licensee must display on the internet site in a prominent place: the licence holders name, licence number, expiry date and either a legible image of the licence or a clearly identifiable link to such an image.

REMOTE SALES

The sale of alcohol by remote sale must comply with section 59 of the act, and section 14 and 15 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises is more precisely identified as outlined in a plan received by the Masterton District Licensing Committee on 19th April 2023.

DURATION

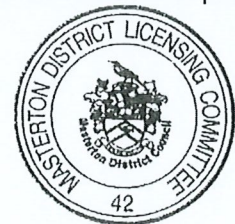
Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licence continues in force-

- a) until its expiry date detailed below; or
- b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence expires, until the close of the period 3 years after the expiry date.
